

Table Summarising the Naroda Patia Incident

Date of Incident	28.2.02 started at 8.30 AM
Place of Incident	Muslim chawls near Noorani Masjid Area and Naroda Patia, chawls opposite the ST Work Shop & shops were first attacked
Major Crimes/ Incidents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the Incident near Pani Ki Tanki wherein 58 persons died including children and women. - The womb of a pregnant woman Kausarbano, was cut open and both the unborn child who was taken out and its mother were burnt - Incidents of Rape of minor girls and women - Incident of a disabled autorickshaw driver Aiyub when he was attacked and burnt
Number of Lives Lost in the Incident	About 95 Muslims, including 30 Men, 32 Women, 33 children and new born children were killed and burnt (Three are missing)
Injured in Incident	About 37, including 8 children, 13 Women and men were injured.
Damage of Property	Damage to households, shops property totalled approximately Rs 4 crores.
Rape	Rape of young women and minor girls including gang rape also occurred.
	Of the carnage of 2002, the incident at Naroda Patiya dated 28.2.2002 was the most grievous. Even today the 400 families who have returned live in fear and trauma.
Details of the Investigation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The FIR was filed at Naroda Police station after which First PI of Naroda K.K. Mysorewala started the investigation. - Soon after the investigation was handed over to the Crime Branch - On November 21, 2003 Supreme Court stayed this trial after names of powerful accused had been dropped. - CJP had intervened in the case filed by the NHRC and on 26.3.2008, the Special Investigation Team (SIT) was appointed for further investigation in Naroda Patiya and the case and to handover the investigation to SIT. - V.V. Chaudhri (from the Gujarat Police) conducted the Investigation for the SIT

Dhandha takeover the charge, there after he was re-transferred.</p> <p>Again Judge Jyotsanaben Yagnik was re-appointed on dt, 14.2.11 as Special Designated Judge.</p>
